F.S.E.O.G. Policy

Effective 07/01/2016 through 06/30/2017

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (F.S.E.O.G.) The FSEOG is a gift program for students who demonstrate exceptional financial need.

The FSEOG program is federally funded for helping the financially needy undergraduate students meet the cost of postsecondary education. This program is administered by Homestead Schools according to the allocated funding level for each award year. **Homestead Schools allocated federal funding level for 2016-2017 Award Year is \$16,317 and the school's nonfederal share is \$5,379. The total amount available to students under FSEOG for 2016-2017 Award Year is \$21,516.** Because the FSEOG is very limited, grants under this program will be awarded only to Federal Pell Grant recipients with the lowest EFC. As funding increases in the future, award will be made available to more Pell eligible students.

Determining Eligibility: In order to determine eligibility for any federal financial aid program, students must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have the results sent to Homestead Schools. Homestead Schools school code is 041497. The Office of Financial Aid will accept results through electronic transmission from the Central Processing System (CPS). Student eligibility is determined only through the CPS of the Department of Education using the Federal Methodology need analysis formula. The Office of Financial Aid must have an official EFC before eligibility for any fund may be determined. Students are notified individually of the amount of their FSEOG eligibility through a paper notification.

Payment: FSEOG funds are disbursed to students at least once each period for those students who are enrolled and have a valid award. Before disbursement the Office of Financial Aid will ensure that the student is eligible for the grant and currently enrolled in the program. The FSEOG is automatically disbursed directly to the student's account tuition and other appropriate outstanding charges are paid before the remaining proceeds are refunded to the student via check. In the event of an over award, the student's award is adjusted to eliminate the over award.

Limits: The regulated annual maximum amount of FSEOG is \$4,000 and the minimum is \$100. However, the Office of Financial Aid has determined self-imposed minimums and maximums to ensure that the greatest number of students with an exceptional need have an opportunity to receive a portion of the FSEOG allocation. **Currently, the maximum award amount per eligible student with an EFC of "0" will be \$400 for an academic year. Students with an EFC higher than zero will be awarded according to the award calculation percentage based on the Pell Grant award schedule.** FSEOG funds are disbursed to students only after an official EFC from the Department of Education has been received.

Priority consideration will be given to the students whose FAFSA is filed and files are complete and verified. After July 1, 2016, new enrollees will be considered for 2016-2017 Award Year FSEOG funds as well as the existing students crossing over to the new award year. The award amount for VN program's 2nd academic year will be prorated based on 649 hours and for MA program the award amount will be based on 720 hours.

Unused Funds: At the end of each Award Year reconciliations will be done to determine if there are any unused FSEOG funds.
